Going to the Marngrook Footy Show was another highlight as we were able to watch the show live and saw ourselves on T.V. Watching two games live at the MCG was also a standout. My favourite thing was being able to go into the club rooms after the win of Port Power Vs Richmond and singing the club song with the whole team.
